About Accreditation:

Many parents have questions about accreditation and what it means. Accreditation is a process by which an accrediting agency assures that a school meets minimum standards set forth by a state board of education. These minimum standards include curriculum, assessment (testing), safety, finances, and teacher qualifications. New Hope Academy chooses to NOT be accredited by AdvancEd (the accrediting agency for most Southern school systems) for the following reasons:

- 1. New Hope Academy is run by qualified staff who have taught in public school systems and hold master's degrees in education. They have over 30 years of combined experience in teaching and administration.
- 2. New Hope Academy staff is constantly training in the latest innovative teaching methods and uses research-based programs in their teaching. Our teachers teach ABOVE the minimum standards required by Alabama.
- 3. The accreditation process is costly and would require us to raise tuition while taking funds away from much-needed programs for our students.
- 4. Students are assessed in several ways throughout the year, including individualized standardized testing in grades 6 12. These assessments allow us to monitor progress and adjust teaching methods and curriculum when necessary.
- 5. New Hope Academy provides a well-rounded educational program that teaches the "whole" child. We incorporate academics, social skills, field experiences, emotional intelligence and fitness into our daily programs. Our instruction is hands-on and exciting, leading to increased retention of information.
- 6. Students who graduate from New Hope Academy are accepted to two-year and four-year colleges and universities without any issues. Our diploma is accepted nationwide, as we follow the Alabama Department of Education requirements for graduation.
- 7. If your child returns to a public school, they may be required to take subject tests in order to be awarded credit in the public school system. This is more common in high school. We will provide a transcript of all work completed at New Hope. It is at the discretion of the local school and district as to whether they will accept credits.
